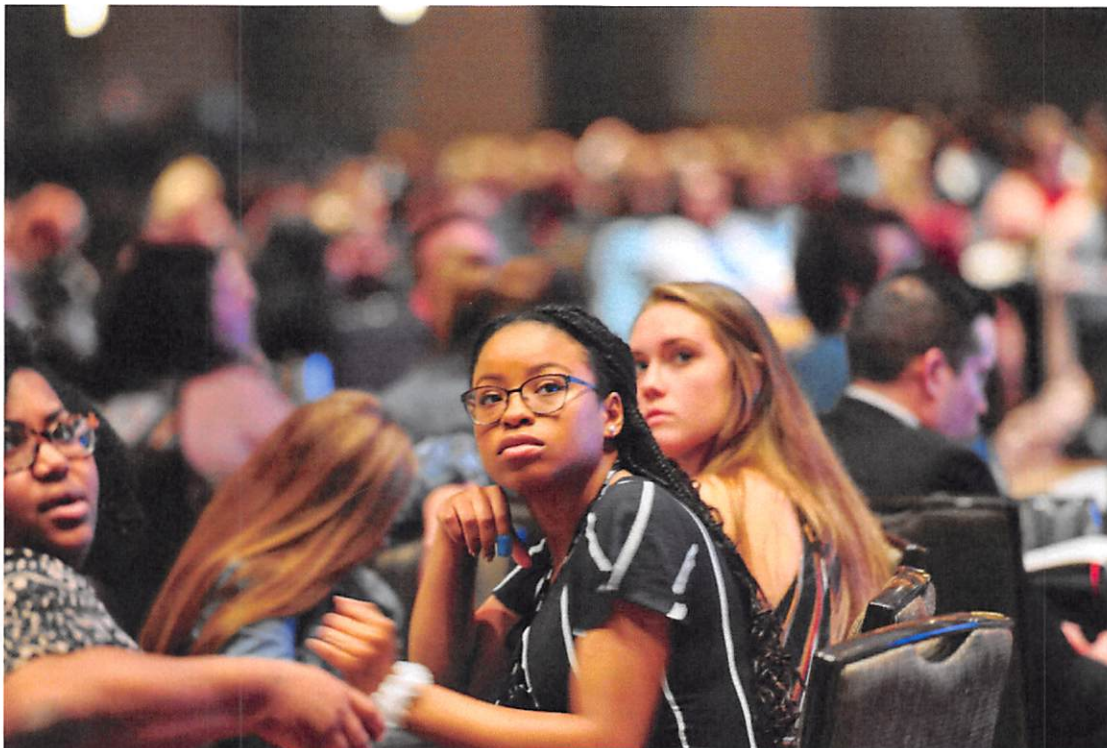
Save the date for the 2022 National Conference!
