Comprehensive Development Plan Exemptions & Waivers

The Comprehensive Development Plan is designed as a required element of the Exemptions & Waivers application that Marble Falls ISD will be submitting to the Texas Education Agency for the 2025-2026 school year. The Exemptions & Waivers application is required for districts who contract teachers who have no bilingual or ESL certification but are serving emergent bilingual students. This plan has three goals as follows:

- 3. To build capacity with other teachers that may serve EB students

- 4. Instructional materials necessary to carry out the success of the state-adopted curriculum used in a Bilingual/ESL classroom
 - i. Consumables
 - ii. Manipulatives

At least 10% of the total Bilingual Education Allotment (BEA) will be allocated to support this comprehensive professional development plan, ensuring that teachers receive targeted training to better serve emergent bilingual (EB) students.
