Summer School Plans for 2017

I. English Language Learners who will be in kindergarten or first grade in the 2017-2018 school year must be offered a summer school program. The district is required to hold summer school if at least 10 ESL students sign up.

<u>Dates</u>: Monday-Thursday, June 5th-July 10th from 7:50-2:30 (July 3rd and 4th will be holidays). 18 days x 6 hours and 40 minutes = 120 hours (8 weeks or 120 hours required).

Staff: 1 teacher, 1 aide

Place: Northwest Elementary

II. The 5th and 8th grade students who did not pass STAAR reading and/or math on the first two attempts are required to have accelerated instruction.

<u>Dates</u>: Monday-Thursday, June 5th-June 19th from 8:00-12:00 and re-testing will be June 20th and 21st.

<u>Staff</u>: Principal-Charles Chesser (for 5th grade) and Richard Sweaney (for 8th grade). The number of teachers will depend on students who need the accelerated instruction.

Place: 5th grade will be at Northwest Elementary, 8th grade will be at High School

III. High School: Credit Recovery and Accelerated Instruction

<u>Dates</u>: Student registration will be Monday, June 5th from 8:00-12:00 and classes will begin on Tuesday, June 6th and will then run Monday-Thursday through June 29th from 8:00-12:00. (The cost to reserve a license will be \$100 per student, but the \$100 will be refunded once student completes the course and obtains the credit). End of Course Accelerated Instruction will be held June 12th-15th and re-testing will be June 19th-23rd.
