Instructional Parameters:

- Teachers will determine standards that need to be retaught, taught to a deeper level, or standards that have not been taught at all this school year. The standards will be mapped out and sent to administration (Scope and Sequence). Test prep should not be included in any capacity as instructional learning.
- 2 Activities a day per subject (at least 20 minutes, no longer than 30)
- 10 minutes of Lexia work per day, no more than 60 minutes per week (students can always be encouraged to continue working on their learning paths for more or less time based on their goals - determine if you need to adjust based on teacher data.)
- Activities need to be outlined by date (will post a week at a time each Friday)
- Activities will not be graded - it's about learning!
- Instructional activities should include an instructional video (when appropriate) from Lexia, Khan Academy, or teacher designed per standard with coordinating activity.
