## **Budget Presentation**

Superintendent Bauer discussed the positve balances in the Education, Operations and Maintenance (Buildings), Transportation and Tort Funds.

The Education fund is projected to have an increase in state revenue as well as expeditures while staying in the black.

Operations and Maintenance fund is expecting a decrease in revenue along with a decrease in expenditures keeping it in the positive.

The Transportation fund is always difficult to predict due to the uncertainty of mandated categorical payments to be received. A decrease in revenue along with a decrease in expenditures is projected to keep the fund in the black for FY19.

The fund with a deficit in the FY19 budget is the Social Security/IMRF Fund, done according to plan due to the levy last year.

# **Public Comment on FY19 Budget**

There were no public comments.

## **Grant Information**

Title grants are down but that is not surprising, as federal revenue is decreasing.

## **Budget Summary**

According to the state, this is considered a balanced budget. As shown in the presentation, the funds projected to be in the postive for FY19 are the Education, Operations and Maintenance, Transportation and Tort funds. The Social Security/IMRF fund shows a deficit for this year. Overall, optimism surrounds the new funding formula and along with careful watch monthly and quarterly of revenues and expenditures, the district will maintain this FY19 budget with no budget deficit reduction plan required.
