working on creating the BPS Infinite Campus Online Registration Platform to be offered to parents beginning April 30, 2023 for the 23-24 School Year. In addition to providing parents/guardians the

convenience of annual school registration accessible through a digital format, the process of online registration will improve the efficiency of the BPS annual Impact Aid application, school nurse duties of entering student medical needs, gathering parent permission slips for field trips, technology use, and other user agreements, as well as homeless, fostercare, and grand-parents raising grandkids programs.
