The network assets being disposed are those that were replaced as part of the multi-year network infrastructure upgrade projects. The computers and monitors being disposed no longer support the educational environment as they have been replaced by newer models or are no longer needed. The District sought proposals from 14 potential vendors. As a result, it is recommended that Com2 Recycling Solutions be awarded the recycling agreement for this equipment. Upon approval, Com2 Recycling Solutions shall pay the District \$4,500 to collect and responsibly dispose, or remarket, the equipment. There will be no additional fees charged to the District as part of this agreement.
