➤ Winter Benchmark Tests and STAAR Released Tests

All students in grades 5-8 have completed the midyear/winter Star 360 benchmark tests in Reading and Math. Also, the Science classes have taken a released STAAR test at each grade level. The benchmark tests measure student progress, identify strengths and weaknesses, and predict outcome of the STAAR tests. The released test results give students and teachers an idea of where to focus instruction as we move closer to the March, April, and May STAAR test dates.
