Teachers have been considering why students are not showing growth as much as we are used to seeing and have come up with the following possible explanations:

- 1.) These benchmark tests are not aligned to the common core state standards so they do not accurately reflect the type and style of learning students are exposed to in the classroom now. Administration is looking in to new tests.
- 2.) Teachers are concerned about how much further behind in the curriculum they are this year (4 day week) compared to previous (5 day week) years.
- 3.) Teachers are concerned about class sizes that keep getting bigger every year with fewer options for small group work with students who need it.

We will continue to monitor student progress and teaching practices to determine what changes we might need to make.

Overall Analysis of results indicates students have stayed about the same in 5^{th} , 6th, and 8th grade. One student has improved in reading in 7th grade. The reason for the differences in percentages is due to the number of students tested. In the winter, 5th grade gained one student, 6th grade lost one student, 7th grade lost two students, and 8th grade stayed the same.
