## IMPORTANT SCHOOL INFORMATION

### **TRANSPORTATION CHANGES:**

If your child will be going home with another student or you need to make a bus change, we need a note from you. Notes must include student's full name, (first & last), date, and parent's signature. Please make sure all transportation notes are sent to the office. If you need to call to change your child's transportation plans for the day, the calls from parents only need to be made prior to **1:00 PM**.

### **STUDENT MEDICATION:**

If your child needs to take medication at school it is a State Law that all medicine to be taken at school is to be brought to school by an adult in the original container and kept in the office. A "**Request for giving Medication Form**" must be filled out by the parent along with the medication. Cough drops are included as a medication and must be in the original container.

### **CONFERENCE DAYS:**
