### Gallup Student Survey

- Grades 6-8, varied by campus
- Surveys non-cognitive measures and their relevance to student success
- \* A web-based survey during an Oct / Nov window
- \* Research-based (Lyubomirsky, King & Diener, 2005, Boehm & Lyubomirsky, 2008; Judge & Hurst, 2008)
- \* Adds student voice to the dialogue about school success

### Gallup Student Survey

\* No Cost to district or student

- Data Tracked for Ten Years (beginning in 2009): So far, 70,000+ students in grades 5-12 have been surveyed from 18 states, 59 districts, 335 schools
- Will receive data reports that may be used with other achievement measures for planning

#### **Three Indicators of Student Success**

\* Hope- the ideas and energy we have for the future

\* Engagement- the involvement in and enthusiasm for school

\* Wellbeing- how we think about and experience our lives
