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Gallup Student Survey

- * Grades 6-8, varied by campus
- * Surveys non-cognitive measures and their relevance to student success
- * A web-based survey during an Oct / Nov window
- * Research-based (Lyubomirsky, King & Diener, 2005, Boehm & Lyubomirsky, 2008; Judge & Hurst, 2008)
- * Adds student voice to the dialogue about school success

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- * No Cost to district or student
- * Data Tracked for Ten Years (beginning in 2009):
So far, 70,000+ students in grades 5-12 have been surveyed from 18 states, 59 districts, 335 schools
- * Will receive data reports that may be used with other achievement measures for planning

Three Indicators of Student Success

- * **Hope**- the ideas and energy we have for the future
- * **Engagement**- the involvement in and enthusiasm for school
- * **Wellbeing**- how we think about and experience our lives
