1 2" three ring binder


12 dividers for 3 ring binder

Calculator

2 rolls of tape

2 Glue Sticks(Math)

2" Heavy Duty D-ring view binder (LA)

Insertable dividers, reinforced, 8 tab (LA)

Nylon pencil pouch that can clip into a 3 ring binder (LA)

Narrow/pen-style highlighters, assorted colors (pink/orange/yellow/green/blue/purple)

Notebook filler paper, college-ruled (LA)

(www.nknsd.org). Cross-country and volleyball practices will begin Wednesday, September 6th, unless otherwise communicated in writing by coaches. The activity buses will be available again this year (days and times to be announced). More info will be provided by coaches once practices begin.

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS: important updates!!!

All students will need <u>two</u> doses of Hepatitis A vaccine by the 2017-2018 school year.

Don't risk exclusion or disease. Make sure your child's vaccinations are up to date. Note: Doses required vary by a child's age and how long ago they were vaccinated.
