Activity: Hire high quality/fully certified teachers for student success in all student groups

Activity: contract with the Regional Education Service Center (ESC) for staff development in areas such as curriculum, reading, math, and other strategic programs as needed.

Activity: attend specific content conferences centered on improving student achievement strategies (i.e., Math CAMT, Reading Academies, etc.)
