Directions:

Hold up one dry spaghetti noodle. Have a student break the noodle in half.

Was that easy? Do you see how easy it is to break one piece of spaghetti?

That's like you being alone and not having anyone to turn to if you need help,

are worried, or just need someone to talk with. It's harder to be strong and

safer when you are by yourself.

Next, take the entire package of dry spaghetti noodles and hold them bunched

together in your hand. Have another student attempt to break the entire

bunch of noodles in half. Why can't you break the noodles? All those noodles

bunched together represent your family and friends who are here to help

you. Being surrounded by family and friends will help protect you. Who are

some of your trusted adults?
