Background Information

The safety of our students and staff is the top priority of Duncanville ISD and the State of Texas. As part of Governor Abbott's school safety directives following the tragedy in Uvalde, the Texas School Safety Center recently conducted an Intruder Detection Audit at one or more of our campuses. These audits assess whether unauthorized individuals can access a campus and help identify areas for improvement, such as securing exterior doors.

We are working closely with our School Safety & Security Committee to address findings, train staff, and enhance campus security. These audits, supported by the state, are one of many steps we are taking to strengthen school safety.

While we understand the community's interest in the audit results, sharing specific details could compromise campus security. Full results will be reviewed in executive session with the Board and discussed with the Safety & Security Committee. Duncanville ISD remains fully committed to maintaining a safe, secure learning environment for all.
