- Initial discussions with Virginia School District
- Parkview Learning Center is "the crown jewel" invest in it now
- Develop a strong Head Start/School Readiness program at Parkview to attract and retain students







- Met with staff to establish and confirm facility space needs
- Learned about concerns with site function and safety
- Toured school to see daily operations and existing spaces







- **Developed concept plan diagram** with knowledge gained from Parkview staff input, District Facilities Management, building and site visit and observation
- After several iterations arrived at Block Schematic Concept Plan
- Plan called for 20,000 s.f. of new construction and 11,000 s.f. of internal remodeling to meet program needs







- Showed Block Schematic Concept Plan to staff for review and comment
- Documented constructive feedback from staff
- Went back and utilized this information to improve the plan







- Revised Block Schematic plan reflects important adjustments to building spaces and site layout
- Revisions intended to affirm most effective locations for all spaces while maintaining appropriate sizes and configurations
- Revised plan also calls for 20,000 s.f. of new construction and 11,000 s.f. of internal remodeling to meet program needs
