FACILITIES RENOVATION

The Board's priorities for funding installation, renovation, upgrade or replacement of facilities are as follows:

- **First Priority** – The protection of life and health (safety and security of students and staff); compliance with mandated federal, state, and county requirements governing construction codes and life safety requirements.
- **Second Priority** – The direct support of the educational program.
- **Third Priority** – Urgently required projects to comply with the priorities set forth in the District's Capital Preservation and Replacement (CPR) Plan for facilities and sites.
- **Fourth Priority** – All Others

The District will encourage the participation of staff, parents, and the community at large in the development of plans for new construction and major renovation of facilities.

The Superintendent will establish procedures for requesting, approving, and scheduling facilities renovations.

Plans for new and remodeled buildings will be designed and offer accommodations to make them accessible to persons with disabilities. The board will review construction plans to assure that new and remodeled buildings are fully accessible.
