Highly Qualified Teachers

Section 1119 of the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB) requires all teachers Teaching core subject academic areas to meet specific competency and educational requirements. Teachers who meet these requirements are considered “highly qualified.”

Teachers are required to be highly qualified if they are teaching any core Academic subject area, including English, reading or language arts, Mathematics, science, foreign languages, civics and government, Economics, arts, history, and geography.
