Justification:

On March 26, 2025, bids were received for the EASD 131 – 2025 Door Replacements project. The project was publicly advertised on March 10, 2025, and a Pre-Bid meeting was held on March 12th. Bids were received for the project's three Base Bid scopes. Three (3) bids were received. Construction Solutions Inc. retracted their bid after bids were received. Please refer to the attached bid results.

The project included scope for door replacements at select doors. Below is a summary along with our recommendations for use at the April 21st, 2025, Board Meeting for direction with award of the project.
