Community Education had 1,000 enrollments on the first day! A new record!






Annual Report






Teacher of the Year Semifinalist

An independent selection panel of 21 community leaders chose the semifinalists from an initial field of 142 candidates from across the state. The panel will review the semifinalists' portfolios again, along with semifinalist video submissions, in March. In the next round, ten finalists will be selected.


Legislative Update
