Testing & Data

Testing went really well. The kids worked hard. Some of the core data reveals a couple of things.

- Two years ago RJ Elementary's fall to fall data showed us at 24% achievement for reading. We are now at a 42% achievement level.
- Two years ago for math we were at a 33% achievement level for Math and are now at 40%

Next Steps-

While we are doing a fantastic job of targeting and providing interventions for our struggling students, we continue to need to consider how to push the top end of our student population. This is a great place to be! For many years, we were having to sped


most of our time targeting students who were achieving at a lower level. It is really a positive sign that our interventions are in place and working.

PreK

We have been conditionally approved for our PreK (EEP) grant. The next step is to move from conditional to full status. We are confident that we will be off of "conditional" by next school year.


STAFF Survey

Fridays are helpful in providing students with interventions we can't cover during a regular day. 10 responses




Growing Leaders is a program that helps us have meaningful conversations about social emotional learning.




The assemblies on Fridays have had a positive impact on students and staff. 10 responses
