We are writing in hopes of receiving free or reduced facility labor fees for the cafeteria staff coverage at Parkrose High School for the 12th Annual Parkrose Dance Competition on February 20th, 2010.

Over the past eleven years, the "Elite" Dance Team has hosted this Dance Team competition in February. The competition has been very successful, and has gained the great reputation of being the "best competition" during the year. Our Parkrose Dance members have benefited greatly from the funds raised during this event. Each year, we have been able to offset the cost each one of our team members pays to participate in our sport. Part of the success of our competition is a direct result of the Parkrose School Board allowing our team to use the facilities at PHS at no cost. Our team pays for custodial services, per an agreement created by Hank Frecke and the previous Facilities Coordinator, Kelly Jones.

Since we began hosting our event in 1999, we have been offering general concessions as well as a Baked Potato lunch to spectators and participants.
