THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Oath of Office

An oath of office is required to be administered to each school board trustee, whether elected, reelected or appointed. The trustee is required to take his/her oath within ten (10) days after the trustee has notice of his/her election or appointment, or within fifteen (15) days from the commencement of his/her term of office. Before any school district trustee elected or appointed enters upon the duties of his/her office, he/she must take the following oath:

I do solemnly swear (or affirm, if re elected) that I will support the Constitution of the United States, and the Constitution of the State of Idaho, and that I will faithfully discharge the duties of Trustee of Homedale School District #370 according to the best of my ability.

The oath is required to be administered by the clerk or by a Trustee. Additionally, the records of the District are required to show that such oath of office has been taken and by whom the oath was administered. Finally, this information is required to be filed with the official records of the District.

A school district t<u>T</u>rustee holds office from <u>January 1</u>the time of the annual meeting in the year in which het <u>or</u> she is elected until the annual meetingJanuary 1 in the year in which hist <u>or</u> her term of office expires, unless: het <u>or</u> she:

- <u>1. <u>d</u>Dies;</u>
- <u>2.</u> <u>FR</u>esigns as trustee;
- <u>3.</u> **F**<u>R</u>emoves him/<u>or</u> herself from the trustee zone of residence;
- 4. <u>FR</u>efuses to serve as trustee;
- 5. $\underline{\mathbf{fF}}$ ails to attend four (4) consecutive regular meetings of the $\underline{\mathbf{bB}}$ oard without an acceptable excuse to the $\underline{\mathbf{bB}}$ oard of $\underline{\mathbf{tT}}$ rustees; or
- <u>6.</u> <u>iIs recalled and discharged from office.</u>

If the school district trustee is appointed, he_{-or} she holds office from the time he_{-or} she takes the oath of office until the next annual meeting of school district trustees January 1 in the year in which the original term of office to which he or she was appointed expires, unless: he_{-or} she:

- <u>1. dD</u>ies;
- <u>2.</u><u>FR</u>esigns as trustee;
- 3. **F**Removes himf or herself from their trustee zone of residence;
- 4. Is no longer a resident or school district elector of the District;
- 5. <u>**FR**</u>efuses to serve as **<u>FT</u>**rustee;
- <u>6.</u> <u>**f**</u><u>F</u>ails to attend four (4) consecutive regular meetings of the <u>**b**</u><u>B</u>oard without an acceptable excuse to the <u>**b**</u><u>B</u>oard <u>of trustees</u>; or
- <u>7. iIs recalled and discharged from office.</u>
