


Semantics:

In these example ōrpomm is translated as "shop" but it has a more significant meaning. It shares meaning with the word pommăkssin, which translates to "transfer," a hallmark feature of niitsiittuyă•pii. Transfers are sacred rites one holds that signifies they have an authority on a specific task. The morpheme ōrpomm could also be translated to "barter" but, for this exercise, it's translated as "shop" to help the learner easier understand what the Blackfoot word refers to in English.
