Each school board that is an active or academy member of the Association is entitled to representation at an annual or special meeting, as follows:

| Group V | 5,001-11,000 | 4 Voting Delegates & Alternates |
| Group VI | 11,001-60,000 | 4 Voting Delegates & Alternates |
| Group VII | Over 60,000 | 4 Voting Delegates & Alternates |

Each school board that is an active or academy member of the Association shall select its delegates and alternates ... and certify [them] to the executive director prior to the annual or special meeting.
