 - 1. Monthly Budget Progress Report: Asst. Supt. Goss reviewed the budget progress report for October, 2015 showing total revenues of \$5,970,598; total expenditures of \$7,730,232; and deficiency of revenues over expenditures of -\$ (1,759,634).

Low energy prices plus warmer weather should equal an energy savings. Bond bids will be held in January for Phase 2 projects, school bus financing. Custodial departure at Tobey elementary: It was agreed, when entering contract, that we would transition to private through attrition over time. Sunset Lake and VAB have been serviced by GRBS all year. In keeping with plan laid out in May, we plan to transfer remaining Tobey staff person to the HS and move Tobey over to GRBS over break.

- F. 1st Reading Approval of G7510A Use of School Facilities and Equipment:
 There has been severe damage, particularly in the HS, over the past 5 years from groups using the gym for practice of outdoor sports such as baseball and softball (holes in gym bleachers, concrete block, scoreboards, floor and lights). Even though people are informed of the guideline changes, violations to the guidelines continue to occur. Requests for such usage have risen significantly in the past five years. The HS floor, walls, lighting, and sprinkler system have just been redone, and the district cannot afford to continue risking damage. Mr. Emmert requested some clarification which will be reviewed for second reading.
