## Unity School District Administrative Rule 436.1 Student Dismissal Precautions 2/12/2019

A child will not be released from school or school activities unless the child's parent/guardian or an adult sibling as named by said parent/guardian authorizes the release. This applies to:

- 1. telephone calls seeking the release of a pupil,
- 2. emails seeking the release of a pupil,
- 3. persons seeking to take the child from a school activity,
- 4. non-custodial parents prohibited by court order from removing the child, and
- 5. any other releases where there is doubt or concern as to the identity or validity of the request.

As a precaution, when receiving such requests, a parent/guardian or an adult sibling may be contacted to verify the request. Written requests for a child's release should include a telephone number and time that the authorized adult could be reached. Students at the elementary and middle schools will be released from the building office to the parent/guardian. If the parent/guardian is not recognized, a check of the driver's license will be made.

If parents who have shared legal and/or shared physical placement (custody) of a child dispute one another's right to remove (pick-up) the child from school, or a school activity, it is the policy of the District not to interfere with the child's removal unless a copy of a court document which prohibits one parent or the other from such removal is provided.
