The Alpena County Board of Commissioners met and was called to order by Chairman Bill Peterson in the County Annex Building, Howard Male Conference Room, Alpena, Michigan and via Zoom on Thursday, April 27, 2023 at 1:00 p.m.

CAMP GRAYLING EXPANSION PRESENTATION

Monty Bolis, Camp Grayling Expansion Group Representative, made a presentation to the board opposing the expansion of Camp Grayling to purchase state land for this expansion. Monty asked the board for support of a resolution opposing this expansion and shared material to the board he sent to them via email. Monty gave a background history and the reason for his groups involvement along with other groups, townships and counties that shared opposition and support.

BUDGET ADJUSTMENT REQUEST - PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE

Prosecutor Cynthia Muszynski presented a budget adjustment request to increase the CVR budget reporting that this is 100% grant funded and was not written into the budget with the correct amount. Cynthia reported that the line item needs to be adjusted to reflect the money they did receive so they can get bills paid. Moved by Commissioner Kozlowski and supported by Commissioner Fournier to approve the below action item. Roll call vote was taken: AYES: Commissioners LaHaie, Osmer, Fournier, Francisco, Konarzewski, Kozlowski, and Peterson. NAYS: None. Motion carried.

Approved in the grant award but not reflected in the original budget. This is 100% grant funded.

FY24 COUNTY VETERANS SERVICE FUND GRANT

County Administrator Mary Catherine Hannah presented the FY24 County Veterans Service Fund (CVSF) Grant Application for approval reporting the Veterans Counselor and Assistant Veterans Counselor are out of town for training. Moved by Commissioner Kozlowski and supported by Commissioner Francisco to approve the below action item. Roll call vote was taken: AYES: Commissioners LaHaie, Osmer, Fournier, Francisco, Konarzewski, Kozlowski, and Peterson. NAYS: None. Motion carried.

AIRPORT RUNWAY PROJECT - PHASE I

County Administrator Hannah presented the Airport Project – Phase I of ANG Project, Fund through county AIP fund. guard is funding this part of the project. two ends of Rwy, contract and bid award for approval (attachment #1). Commissioner Konarzewski requested he be excluded from the vote as he has a financial gain to this project. Moved by Commissioner Kozlowski and supported by Commissioner Francisco to approve Commissioner Travis Konarzewski be excluded from voting on this project. Motion carried. Moved by Commissioner LaHaie and supported by Commissioner Kozlowski to approve the below action item. Roll call vote was taken: AYES: Commissioners LaHaie, Osmer, Fournier, Francisco, Kozlowski, and Peterson. NAYS: None. Commissioner Travis Konarzewski abstained. Motion carried.

ANIMAL CONTROL SURVEY

County Administrator Hannah presented the Animal Control Survey for approval to ask for community engagement. Discussion whether to do survey or not and what options are available. Administrator Hannah reported that the survey was amended to include requiring names and street addresses, which can be verified and if not and if questions are not answered will not be allowed as part of the survey. The board shared some of their concerns and recommended to make some decisions after the public input of the surveys and budget for 2024. Moved by Commissioner Kozlowski and supported by Commissioner Konarzewski to approve the below action item. ALPENA DDA & TARGET SERVICE AGREEMENTS

County Administrator Hannah presented the Alpena DDA Service Agreement and the Target Service Agreement for review and approval. Discussion on agreements and noting that the DDA can apply for Grants for downtown from MEDC and the benefits the DDA has access to. Discussion on Target and the resources they have access to promote Alpena County property and businesses. Administrator Hannah reported that the DDA is required per the contract to give the board an update twice a year. Moved by Commissioner Konarzewski and supported by Commissioner Osmer to approve the below action item. Roll call vote was taken: AYES:

Commissioners LaHaie, Osmer, Francisco, Konarzewski, Kozlowski, and Peterson. NAYS: Commissioner Fournier. Motion carried.

ACTION ITEM #8: Recommendation to approve service agreement with Alpena DDA in the amount of \$5,000 per year and service agreement with Target Alpena in the amount of \$10,000 per year, with both agreements prorated beginning July 1, 2023 and expiring December 31, 2027 as presented.

County Administrator Hannah presented the budget adjustment request to increase the Target Service Agreement line item and the DDA Service Agreement line item and to decrease the Contingency line item for the 2023 budget year for approval. Moved by Commissioner Konarzewski and supported by Commissioner Francisco to approve the below action item. Roll call vote was taken: AYES: Commissioners LaHaie, Osmer, Francisco, Konarzewski, Kozlowski, and Peterson. NAYS: Commissioner Fournier. Motion carried.

ACTION ITEM #9: Recommendation to approve an increase of the Target Service Agreement line item 101-200-801.006 by \$5,000; and an increase of the Alpena DDA Service Agreement line item 101-200-801.007 by \$2,500; and to decrease the Contingency line item 101-941-955.000 by \$7,500 and to authorize the Treasurer to make the budget adjustments as presented.

DHHS BUILDING LEASE (711 W. Chisholm St.)

County Administrator Hannah reported that the Facilities Committee reviewed and recommended bringing the RFP with lessee for the old DHHS building at 711 W. Chisholm Street in Alpena to the Full Board for approval. Administrator Hannah informed the board that the County Maintenance is working on the renovations and would like to finalize the lease with I2P and get a security deposit. Administrator Hannah reported they are in the final stages to meet their request and did not have a standard commercial lease and she reached out to outside council on this lease with the only outstanding issue is the property taxes. Administrator Hannah presented the lease with I2P for a security deposit and first months rent with taxes worked in and to request a signature from them before they move in for approval. Discussion and recommendation to approve. Moved by Commissioner Fournier and supported by Commissioner Konarzewski to approve the lease with i2P, LLC located at 711 W. Chisholm Street, Alpena, MI 49707 for a term of 6 years starting on the date of signature and receipt of security deposit and first month's rent. Roll call vote was taken: AYES: Commissioners LaHaie, Osmer, Fournier, Francisco, Konarzewski, Kozlowski, and Peterson. NAYS: None. Motion carried.
