- Enrollment: 1,823 Students.
- > Open Enrollment: 303 Students which is 16.6% of the total enrollment.
- Feeder Schools: Wilson K-8, Coronado K-8, Painted Sky Elementary, and Copper Creek Elementary.
- ▶ IRHS has a very small ELL population at .5%.
- 12.5% of our student population is identified gifted in at least one area in the 2014-2015 school year.
- Students identified Special Education make up 10.2% of our school population.
- Average Daily attendance rate in 2014-2015 was 92.9%.
- Student Mobility Rate in 2014-2015 was 12.1%.
- > 14% of students at Ironwood Ridge High School qualify for free and reduced lunch.
- Ironwood Ridge High School has many active partnerships with the surrounding business community.
- Ironwood Ridge High School was built in 2000-2001 and many members of the parent population were students here or long time members of the Amphitheater district.
- Ironwood Ridge High School has a great reputation for preparing students for postsecondary education. We have strong academics, outstanding fine arts and competitive athletic teams.
