Construction

Public Presentation/Public Approval

The Board of Education recognizes that presentation for public approval of construction projects by Board members and school employees shall be carried out in strict compliance with the law. The Board of Education may set standards for such presentations.

The Board of Education further recognizes that the Town's Permanent Building Committee shall be the agent of the Town for the construction, alteration and/or addition to any educational facility. The Permanent Building Committee's responsibilities regarding such projects shall include, but is not limited to, working collaboratively with the Board to make presentations at town meetings for the purpose of seeking approval of a project and for recommendations of action after the solicitation of bids.
