► School Messenger System

School Messenger is an automated calling system that the District uses for attendance calls, to notify parent of special events, but most importantly to notify parents of an unexpected, weather related, school closure. The system will call the phone numbers that are in your child's student record. Please review and update your child's parent contact information at the beginning of the year and any time during the year that contact information changes.

It is <u>VERY IMPORTANT</u> that our schools have the most current parent contact information.

► FlashAlert System

FlashAlert is the service we use to provide notice of emergency closures to the Portland television and radio stations. The system will send you a text and/or email message. You may log in and request a test message to revalidate your account.

Mealtime Lunch Program

Neah-Kah-Nie School District is excited to announce that the USDA and Oregon Department of Education have extended the no cost meal programs for schools through the end of the 2020-2021 school year. This means we will continue to provide meals to community children 18 and under at **no cost until the school year ends in June 2021.**

We do encourage families who attend Neah-Kah-Nie School District to **fill out a Free/Reduced application so your student(s) will have a 30 day carry over for the 2021-2022 school year.** If you do not fill out an application to see if you qualify for free or reduced meals under the Federal or Oregon Extended Income Guidelines, your student(s) will automatically have to pay for meals when school starts in September 2021.

If you feel you would qualify for free or reduced lunches and have not applied you can do that online on the NKN website. If your child was on the free/reduced lunch program last year - you NEED TO REAPPLY each year. https://www.mymealtime.com/

If you are unable to access the internet, please contact the school your student(s) attend and they can mail you an application to return to the school or district office. Please return one application per household, not per student.
