Parent Involvement

- PTO Balance is currently \$15, 853.17

- We have a space in the girl's "locker room/restroom" off the gym for PTO storage. This will be temporary storage as it was cleaned out in preparation for the seismic upgrade. Please know that if the seismic upgrade moves forward all items will need to be removed before the summer. If it does not occur the school will need to move the items back that were removed for the seismic upgrade (I hope that makes sense). PTO will need to discuss a permanent storage option. Other PTAs and PTOs at neighboring elementary schools have purchased sheds. We could discuss location being more accessible and well lit if PTO purchases a shed. We are very tight on space around the school.
- Classified Staff Appreciation Week: Thank you for the yummy soup and other gifts of appreciation!
- Kaci provided a status update. She and Ms. Falkenhagen met with Play Kraft at the school. The proposal is to put an ADA ramp in from the sidewalk, remove the pea gravel, and replace it with tiles (like All sports park). There are also some code issues that need to be dealt with. One swing set is too close to another one, so we are

considering removing and replacing the older one and moving it further away. ADA swings would be on the new structure. Pea gravel is not ADA compliant. Ms. F also wants the monkey bar dome removed, so Kaci is looking at replacement structures that are safer and more modern. The next step is to get measurements over to Play Kraft so that they can provide a quote. Megan is going to get a fancy measuring tape from her dad and help Kaci. Play Kraft sent Kaci a list of grants that we may qualify for to cover all or part of the cost. Daniella has graciously offered to help us apply for the grants, so Kaci is working to get her the information she needs to complete the applications.

- Bingo Night – Megan and Christy are co-chairing this event and it will be held on March 19th. Megan provided an update on prizes gathered so far. We didn't get any responses from the Parent square post asking for donations. Krissy was able to get Baldini's to donate 4 \$25 gift certificates, and Jordan will get some wine donated from Schmidt Winery. Megan and Christy are working on some other local businesses. We will need volunteers to help with concessions that night, so Megan will reach out when we get closer to the event. Krissy will help Megan with running the board again.
- Book Fair Volunteers – Carly is organizing volunteers for March 10-13th to help with the book fair during the school day. We still have a few open spots. Ann volunteered to fill a spot on Thursday and Hilary filled a spot on Wednesday. There are still a few open spots on Wed & Thursday, so please contact Carly if you can help.
- Administrative Assistant Appreciation Day – is on April 23rd. Megan volunteered to get a gift and drop it off in the morning that day. There is a \$100 budget, and we need to clarify with Ms. F who exactly we need to get a gift for.
- Steam night/Book fair night – is March 13th and we had planned to get volunteers to sell spirit wear. We discussed whether we should sell it in the library and just have the 3 book fair volunteers also sell spirit wear or if we should have a table closer to the action (since not everyone goes to the library during steam night). Kaci volunteered to sell it and potentially put the table where it makes the most sense. Krissy to send her a Cheddar up link, and Carly to get her the merch.
- Teacher Conference Dinner – April 10th. Ms. F requested we get the teachers dinner that night since they are staying late for conferences. Taco platters from Casa Amiga were suggested. Megan is going to call them for pricing and to see if they would donate a portion. Krissy volunteered to pick up and deliver that evening. Kaci motioned to approve \$250 for this event, Megan seconded, all voted in favor.
- Glow dance planning – April 24th. Natalie is chairing the event. We have a small budget for this event, and it was mentioned that might not be enough, so we need to

get an idea from Natalie on what the proposed budget is and then vote on additional spending at the next meeting, if needed.

- Teacher Appreciation week – May 5-8th. Historically the PTO does a catered lunch one of the days and a gift to each teacher. Last year Christy also did donuts and coffee one day, and possibly other small gifts. Kaci, Hilary, Lauren, and Ann volunteered to team up for this event. They will contact Christy to find out all that was done last year. The budget for this is \$600.
- Color Run – May 22nd. Hilary and Carly volunteered to co-chair this event. Jordan and Krissy volunteered to assist in whatever way is needed.

Instruction

- ALL grade levels have shown growth in math Beginning of the Year to Middle of the Year (These scores are the district assessments - DIBELS). We are working on 4 strategies for being a great test taker with our 3rd-5th graders. State testing will begin in the middle of April. We had 36 students participate in this year's District Science Fair! STEAM night will happen next week and all science fair projects will be on display.
