




Snapshot of English Learners In Denton ISD





















STAAR READING, MATH & SCIENCE GRADE 5 PERFORMANCE

STAAR READING & MATH GRADE 6




STAAR READING, MATH & WRITING GRADE 7




STAAR READING, MATH, SCIENCE, & SOCIAL STUDIES GRADE 8

PERCENTAGE OF ESL STUDENTS PERFORMING AT THE APPROACHES LEVEL








STAAR READING PERFORMANCE FOR PROGRAM EXIT: MONITORED YEAR 1 & YEAR 2






