It is our expectation that every student will be presenting their student led conference to a caring adult.

Fleming MS was selected nationally to participate in a MS Longitudinal Study. We had 20 6th graders randomly selected to participate in this study. If your child was selected, you have received a letter in the mail with information and a non-participating form. If you do not want your child to participate, please return to the office. The testing and participation will happen March 8th & 9th.

Fleming MS will be re-establishing our National Junior Honor Society chapter. Academically eligible students have been determined and invited to apply. An information meeting will be held with students March 1st. It is only for 7th and 8th graders. Our Induction Ceremony will be the evening of March 21st. Our chapter service project will be reading with students at Manzanita Elementary.
