Re: Purchase of Maintenance Vehicle

I would like to request adding an agenda item to the December 5, 2022 Committee of the Whole Meeting to discuss an order to purchase one F-250 pick-up truck. This 2023 model year truck will replace the current 1997 wrecker and the 1996 vehicle used by the service garage mechanics, known as the "yard tug". The current "yard tug" is equipped with a push bumper and is used by the mechanics to move dead vehicles on LPS premises, or to move vehicles aside to get them off the road. It is also equipped with a jump starter in the back. The new F-250 would replace both the tug and the wrecker and will have the same capabilities.

This truck will come from Gorno Ford, Woodhaven, Michigan via the State of Michigan's MiDEAL purchasing program, at a cost of \$51,698.00 from the General Fund.
