B. Minnesota Department of Education Assistive Technology Teams Project Grant

Barbara Connelly, Occupational Therapist and Assistive Technology Coordinator, presented on the Minnesota Department of Education (MDE) Assistive Technology (AT) Teams Project Grant. The 3-4 year grant is a partnership between MDE, the Regional Low Incidence Project through Metro ECSU and 6 local districts. The first year goal is to review current practices and develop district action plans to improve outcomes for students with disabilities using the Student-Environment-Task-Tools (SETT) framework model. The second year goals are to increase independent use of AT and integrate it into the general classroom through collaboration with students and staff. The third/fourth year goal is to implement a professional development plan which would support the understanding of AT devices and services to enable students to accomplish Individual Education Programs (IEP) goals. The grant also includes several training sessions per year by national speakers. The Mahtomedi School District team consists of the district's Special Education Supervisor, Special Education teachers and the Technology Director.

9. DISCUSSION/INFORMATION ITEMS

A. Calendar of Events

The Calendar of Events was reviewed.

B. Guidance Department Update on Minnesota Career Information System (MCIS)

Jennina Boskovich, Mahtomedi Middle School Counselor, and Ellen Cole, Mahtomedi High School Counselor, updated the school board members on the Minnesota Career Information System (MCIS) an online career and college exploration tool sponsored by MDE. Boskovich explained the introduction of MCIS Jr. in Grade 7 which allows students to explore the system with an Occupation Scavenger Hunt and a Career Cluster Inventory and in Grade 8 students take the Interest Profiler and complete the IDEAS Interest Survey. Cole explained ninth grade students retake the Career Cluster Inventory to help them develop a four year high school course plan and students in Grades 10-12 continue to update their course plan and career goals along with a Reality Check program that helps them learn how much money they will need to earn and identify occupations that will provide a salary that meets their needs. The system

allows them to search for colleges using School Sort and research financial aid using the Financial Aid Sort. Boskovich demonstrated the MCIS for school board members.

C. First Reading of Annually Reviewed Policies, New Polices and Policies with MSBA Recommended Changes
