Background Information:

- Texas law (Texas Education Code, Title 2, Subtitle F, Chapter 28, Subchapter A, §28.004) requires the establishment of a school health advisory council (SHAC) for every school district. According to Board Policy BDF(Legal), The board shall establish a local SHAC, who shall meet at least four times each year, to assist the district in ensuring that local community values are reflected in the district's health education instruction. The board shall appoint members to the SHAC from the community and the district. The majority of members must be parents of enrolled students and who are not employed by the district.
- SHACs play an important role in strengthening the connection between health and learning.

Administrative Considerations:

- The membership application for the 2026-27 SHAC, referencing applicable Texas Law, Board Policy, and SHAC Bylaws, was sent to Keller ISD families on May 6, 2026 remained open through May 20, 2026. 66 applications were received.
- The membership list, attached, was developed through trustee selection. Each trustee selected four people, with at least two of the four being parents of enrolled students who are not employed by the district. The membership list also includes district support staff.
