BB 9110 BOARD MEMBERSHIP (Second Read)

Regular Members

The School Board shall consist of five (5) members elected or appointed in accordance with law.

Military Delegate

Note: If the city or borough school board operates a school on a military reservation, the School Board is required to appoint one nonvoting military delegate. The following sample bylaw may be revised or deleted to reflect district philosophy and needs.

The Board may appoint a delegate from the military community to serve on the Board in a nonvoting capacity. The delegate shall receive non-confidential Board materials, attend public sessions of the Board, and advise the Board relating to the management and control of military schools, *as appropriate*.

The military delegate may cast and have recorded in the Board minutes a preferential vote which shall not be counted in the Board vote.

Student Representatives to the Board Members

The Board believes it is important to seek and consider students' ideas, viewpoints, and reactions to the educational program. In order to provide student input and involvement, the Board shall appoint acknowledge student designated representatives to the Board members as deemed necessary a welcomed voice at the table.

Student Board members Representatives shall have the right to attend public meetings of the Board, be recognized at meetings, participate in questioning witnesses and discussing issues and shall receive all materials presented to Board Members except those related to executive sessions and materials that are otherwise confidential in nature.

Student Board members Representatives may cast preferential votes on all matters except those subject to executive session discussion. Consultatory votes shall be cast prior to the official Board vote and shall not be numerically factored into the outcome of a vote. Consultatory votes shall be recorded in the Board minutes.
