

## High School Board Report 4-13-21

### Overview

- Planning for high school summer school opportunities have been occurring. High school summer school consists of credit recovery opportunities for students who failed a course during the school year for various reasons. High school summer school will take place June 7th through June 25th. Sessions occur Monday through Thursday from 8:00 -12:00. Needs assessments are taking place and families are being contacted by their counselor. This process will continue through May to identify students who would benefit from this option.
- The state mandated ACT test occurred on Tuesday, March 9th. All juniors take the assessment. Grades 9, 10 and 12 did not physically report to school that day in order to create a safe and successful testing environment. Administration of the exam went smoothly and thank you to our families for helping us with administering exams.
- April 5th staff inservice consisted of two primary sessions. Mrs. Burzynski facilitated the next progression of our building work on Grading for Learning, specifically learning targets and success criteria. Mrs. Simonis facilitated, along with Dr. Hartwig, continued learning about the B.e.s.t. Screener and how to interpret student data to identify successful interventions.
- High school students returned to full attendance on April 6th. School staff and teachers spent a great deal of time preparing to serve students in this new instructional model. Additionally, daily logistics were modified to accommodate students. We are early in this transition and things are going smoothly at this point in time.
