Advanced Opportunities Usage by HSD Students

• Advanced Opportunities provides 7th - 12th-grade students with a line of credit they can use to pay for college-level dual credit courses, exams and overload classes. Public and charter school students can receive up to \$4,625. The majority of the funds were used for dual-credit classes. \$88,980.00 was paid out for these opportunities for Homedale students. 181 students participated. 30.94% of our students participated in the program. We rank in the middle of the pack in the state as far as student usage. The average expenditure per student in Homedale was \$491.60. This is a great opportunity for students and we will strive to increase participation in the program.
