Team of staff members who make contact with students/families that are identified by weekly attendance reports. These are students who have missed 4 or more periods in a week.

- Individual Student/Parent Support
- Connecting Families to SAT Team Resources/Supports
- Provide Updates to Teachers/Case-Manager

- Alternative Distance Learning Plans

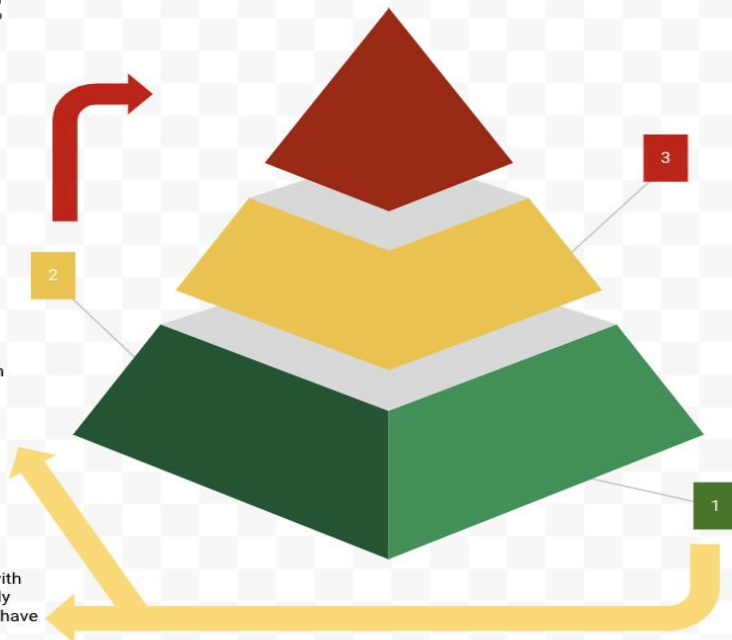
Tier I-Teacher Managed
