Mr. Melnick asked a question regarding the obsolete books. Ms. Linda Callahan, Library Media Specialist, was present at the meeting and responded that there were 22 books that were declared obsolete. She said that those books were out-of-date and in very poor condition.

Mrs. Davis asked a question regarding the increased profit for the cafeteria program this year. Mrs. Peters stated that the Medicaid eligibility changed about a year ago, which has helped increase revenue for the program.

B. Negotiation Committee

The Negotiation Committee members are Mrs. Locke, Ms. Shegogue and Mrs. Davis. Mrs. Locke reported that the committee has completed negotiations with CSEA (non-certified staff members) without going to mediation. She said that CSEA will hold a ratification meeting within the next few weeks.

Item VII. Superintendent's Reports

G. <u>2018 – 2019 Financial Report, July 1 – April 30, 2019</u>

Mrs. Diane Peters, Business Manager, presented the 2018 - 2019 financial report that covered the period beginning July 1, 2018 through April 30, 2019. She stated that the budget balance is \$113,808.68, not including the MBR adjustment of \$239,655.00. Mrs. Peters stated that she projects approximately \$50,000 to remain at the conclusion of the fiscal year.

There were no questions or comments.

A. High School Music and Drama Presentation

Mrs. Dillon, music and drama coordinator, introduced the music and drama students that were present at the meeting. There were student representatives from choir, show choir, madrigals, ladies' choral, and band.

Mr. Moccio stated that the talent, dedication, and hard work of the students, as well as the inclusive and supportive environment they create is very apparent in all of their interactions at the schools and in the community.

B. <u>Teacher of the Year 2020</u>

Mr. Moccio announced that Stafford's Teacher of the Year for 2020 is Mrs. Lynn Erickson, District Technology Integration Specialist. He said that the announcement of this selection was during the 1st Annual Teacher and Paraeducator of the Year Staff Reception, which was held at Stafford High School on May 16, 2019. Mr. Moccio introduced Mr. Autieri, Director of Curriculum and Instruction, who facilitates the selection process.

Mr. Autieri outlined the Teacher of the Year selection process and shared portions of Mrs. Erickson's nominations, which highlighted her dedication and care for students. Mrs. Erickson was presented with an engraved clock on behalf of the district and the Board. Her name will also be added to the TOY plaque that was created by the high school's industrial technology department.

C. Paraeducator of the Year 2020

Mr. Moccio announced that Stafford's Paraeducator of the Year for 2020 is Ms. Kathy Callahan, Paraeducator at Staffordville School. He said that similar to the CSDE Teacher of the Year program, the nominee must meet specific criteria, which is outlined in the announcement letter that was sent to staff, parents, and community members. Mr. Moccio introduced Ms. Jolene Piscetello, Director of Pupil Services.

Ms. Piscetello highlighted some of Ms. Callahan's accomplishments and contributions to the school community. Ms. Callahan was presented with an engraved clock on behalf of the district and the Board.

He said that the 2018-2019 recipients of this prestigious award from Stafford High School are Abigail Napolitano and Samuel Yefko. Both students are eleventh graders. He said that the recipients from Stafford Middle School are Collin Gudeman and Samuel Suchecki. Collin is in eighth grade and Samuel is in seventh grade.

The four honorees were present at the *Celebration of Excellence*. Mr. Marco Pelliccia, Principal of Stafford High School, Mr. Timothy Kinel, Assistant Principal of Stafford High School, Mrs. Susan Mike, Principal of Stafford Middle School, and Mr. Jonathan Campbell, Assistant Principal of Stafford Middle School, spoke about each of these students and their contributions to the school and the community. Each student was presented with a certificate.
