Students Provide Own Transportation to and from the DFW airport

February 20, 2026

Saturday March 6th

Depart from DFW for our flight to Glasgow, arrival early morning



March 7th Arrive Glasgow Airport early on the 6th to be met by your Scottish Tour Guide & Coach Driver. We then travel north along the shores of Loch Lomond. Up through the spectacular pass of Glencoe and into Fort William where we will make a stop.

We continue up the Great Glen where we board a cruise ship that carries us up Loch Ness to Urquhart Castle for our visit there. Urquhart Castle, is about 800 years old. Its location was chosen for its advantageous position on a rocky precipice allowing the alarm to be raised when the castle was at risk of attack. After our visit there, we continue into Inverness for a two-night stay. Hotel and dinner: Palace Hotel, Inverness



March 8th Travel north from Inverness. Drive over the Struie Hills towards Bonar Bridge. Stop at the layby called the Queens view with its views over the Kyles of Sutherland. Continue to the Royal Burgh of Dornoch with its beautiful Cathedral sitting in the town square. The cathedral is clad with a warm, honey-colored stone that makes the whole interior warm. Although early settlements are recorded as early as the 8th century, the town was first recognized in the 13th century. We'll have some free time in Dornoch to explore this Royal Burgh. The nearby town of





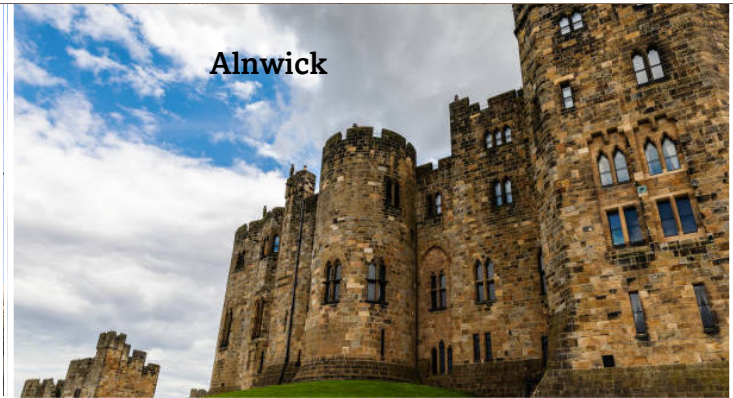
Tain is the oldest Royal Burgh in Scotland with a charter dating back to 1066. Return to Inverness. The rest of the day is free in Inverness, a good shopping town. Dinner on our own in one of the restaurants along the river. Palace Hotel, Inverness. (Possible Concert in Dornoch Cathedral.)

March 9th Depart Inverness and travel south towards the city of Perth and over to Stirling for a visit to Stirling Castle and the Church of the Holyrood. The castle sits atop an intrusive crag. It is surrounded on three sides by steep cliffs, giving it a strong defensive position. We then continue towards Edinburgh stopping for a quick look at the Kelpies. Two magnificent steel structures of horse's heads to celebrate the Clydesdale horses, native to Scotland and know as the great servants. Dinner and overnight at the Radisson Blu Hotel, Edinburgh at 80 High St, in the heart of the Old Town on the Royal Mile



March 10th Morning city tour of Edinburgh and St Giles Cathedral, with a concert at St. Giles. St Giles' Cathedral, founded in 1124 by King David I, has been a working church for over 900 years. It's stained-glass windows are among the most praised in Europe. Remainder of the day free to enjoy the sights and sounds of Scotland's Capital City, including Edinburgh Castle at the top of the hill, Mary King's Close, unique shops and famous taverns. Overnight

Radisson Blu Hotel, Dinner on your own. Formal concert at St Giles Cathedral



March 11th Depart Edinburgh and travel round the North East Coastal route towards





Alnwick Castle. A must-do for any Harry Potter fans as most of the Filming was done there. It also boasts one of the most beautiful gardens in the United Kingdom at Alnwick. Continue south through Newcastle stopping for a picture stop at the massive steel statue known as the Angel of the North. We then continue down through the very scenic Yorkshire Dales National Park and into the Medieval Walled City of York midafternoon. Time for a walk about in town and view the cathedral. Hotel and dinner: Hilton York Hotel, York



March 12th (Leave early) Today, we continue down through the heart



of England. Our route takes us through Lincolnshire with its many rivers and beautiful rolling countryside. The city of Lincoln has a beautiful cathedral with a spire that can be seen from many miles away. Continuing down through Nottinghamshire, of course we'll see the woodlands that include Sherwood Forest. And the legendary Robin Hood. Our route takes us further south to the university city of Cambridge for a short visit before continuing into London. Hotel and dinner: Holiday Inn Regents Park, Carburton St, London W1W 5EE, London



March 13th Meeting at 9:30 PM at the coaches, our guides take us to enjoy a guided panoramic tour of the city by coach, including Piccadilly Circus, Oxford St., Parliament, Big Ben, Trafalgar Square, Hyde Park, Buckingham Palace, and other sights. Then our coaches take us to the Tower of London (adm. incl.), where we will have lunch on our own before entering the Tower grounds for our guided tour. Built by William the Conqueror in 1070, the Tower was a royal residence until the time of King Henry the 8th, after which it



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was renowned as a feared and sinister prison. The closely guarded Crown Jewels are on display at the Tower, and you will have the opportunity to see the Royal Apartments of King Edward 1st. Then we depart by tube for a visit to St. Paul's Cathedral in the heart of London, the masterpiece of England's great architect Sir Christopher Wren and burial place of famous Britons such as Horatio Nelson and the Duke of Wellington. Arriving at about 1:00 PM, we have time to tour the cathedral and hear about its great history with our London guide.

Following dinner on our own, we attend our West-End Show TBD. Hotel: Holiday Inn Regents Park, Carburton St, London

March 14th After breakfast at the hotel, the coaches will take us to Buckingham Palace to see the Changing of the Guard, one of the most observed events in Europe. Then we walk to nearby Westminster, where we'll have free time to visit Westminster Abbey (on our own). Then we walk to the Embankment, where we board a tour boat for our guided cruise down the Thames River to see London from the water. We'll disembark near London Bridge, and from there we walk the short distance to Shakespeare's Old Globe Theater, a restoration of the original theater, very much as seen in "Shakespeare in Love", a recently popular movie. We conclude our day by transferring to Covent Garden, a popular shopping area and home of St. Paul's Church.

This is where we perform our last concert. Tonight's dinner is a special event since it's the last night of the tour. Hotel: Holiday Inn Regents Park, Carburton St, London

TOUR CONTRACT

This agreement is made between Select Tours by Sabol & Associates, of Chichester, N.H., herein known as "The Agent", and the Billy Ryan High School Choir herein known as "the Client", as of date on signature page. In consideration of mutual agreements herein contained, the parties consent to the following:

1. FARES:

The prices to the Client for its participants, based on the hotel occupancy levels shown, on listed inclusions, and on conditions stated throughout this agreement (especially as marked with an * in Par. 3.), are as follows:

1. The full package at **double** occupancy: *\$3,991.00
2. The full package at **single** occupancy: *\$4,921.00
3. The full package at **triple** occupancy: *\$3,991.00 (limited availability, first-come, first served)

2. TRANSPORTATION:

The Agent will provide the Client with motorcoach transportation for participants of the tour as follows: Luxury air-conditioned motorcoach transfers from Glasgow, Scotland to London, UK for all activities in the UK and Scotland as per the itinerary (including drivers' gratuities). Transportation by Underground Thursday March 11 and Friday, March 12th (included)

Air Transportation will be provided as follows, for up to 50 passengers via British Aiir or similar, pending any changes made by the airline:

From Dallas on March 4, 2026 at 11:00 AM on British Air or similar
To arrive at Glasgow or Edinburgh on March 5, 2026 at 9:00 AM, and
Returning from London Heathrow on March 13, 2026 at @ 11:00 AM
To arrive at Dallas on March 13, 2026 at @ 6:10 PM

3. INCLUSIONS:

The Agent will provide the Client with the following tour items, which make up the package:

- 1. Scheduled commercial air transportation from DFW Airport to Glasgow and return from London with in-flight meal service
- 2. Luxury air-conditioned motorcoach transfers throughout the tour as per the itinerary (including drivers' gratuities)
- 3. Accommodations throughout the tour in four or three star hotels: two nights at the Inverness Palace Hotel & Spa on the River Ness, two nights at the four-star Radisson Blue Hotel in Edinburgh on the Royal Mile, one night at the Holiday in York, and three nights at the 4-star Holiday Inn Regent Park in London.
- 4. Full hot buffet breakfast each morning at the hotel, one dinner each in Inverness (at the hotel), one dinner in Edinburgh, one dinner in York (at the hotel), a dinner in London, and a gala dinner on the final night of the tour. (Five dinners total included).
- 5. The full time assistance of a licensed professional tour guides in Scotland and the UK to give commentary about the sites to be toured and their significance as well as the sights along the way as we travel (including tour guide gratuities)
- 6. Admission fees to attractions to include Loch Ness & Urquhart Castle cruise, Stirling Castle, Church of the Holy Rude, St Giles Cathedral, Edinburgh, Alnwick Castle, St Pauls Cathedral, and the Tower of London incl. viewing the Crown Jewels
- 7. Arrangement for two formal concert performances during the tour; one in the Edinburgh Cathedral, if permitted, and one at St. Paul's Church in London, or similar (based on availability)
- 8. The services of a Select Tours escort at all times at the destination to oversee the smooth operation of
- 9. Two adults free, one single and one double occupancy, based pm 48 paying passengers

3.1 PRICING CONDITIONS:*Pricing is based on a minimum of 50 paying passengers and a maximum of 48 total passengers per coach. All prices subject to changes in taxes, exchange rates, and surcharges, especially airline fuel surcharges. Other elements of the program may change based on availability in 2026. Pricing is based on an exchange rate of \$1.33 to the euro. There is also a possibility of a Scottish Tourist Tax that may be added to the cost. The air cost is estimated based on past records so we expect it to be accurate. However, it cannot be guaranteed in the price until the final air contract has been signed.

4. PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

In order to guarantee the prices quoted in this contract between the Client and The Agent, a signed copy of this agreement must be forwarded by and sufficient enrollment must be demonstrated by April 1, 2026.

Per-passenger payments will be made by the Client to The Agent as follows:

Eight total payments are scheduled:

- A. Seven payments of \$500 per paying passenger starting with April 1, May 1, June 1, July 1, August 1, September 1, and October 2026 (for a total of \$3500)
- B. A final payment of the balance per paying passenger is \$494.94, or \$1,421 single on November 1 2026

All payments shall be made to the client through the Ryan High School Choir Booster Club and sent to the Select Tours by Sabol and Associates corporate account or mailed by secure service requiring signature.

5. CANCELLATION POLICY:

Cancellation charges: Cancellations and requests for refunds must be submitted in writing to Select Tours, at 151 Webster Mills Rd., Chichester, NH 03258. All documents, including tickets of any value, must be returned before any refund can be processed.

The following cancellation charges are provided as a disincentive for passengers to cancel. The charges that are generated are used to offset increased per-person costs that result from a reduced number of passengers (e.g.: fewer passengers to cover the cost of motorcoach transportation).

1. From date of the first deposit until 120 days before departure the charge is 25% of full price (\$977.75)
2. At 119 days before departure, the charge increases to 50% of full price (\$1,955.50)
3. At 90 days before departure, the charge increases to 75% of full price (\$2,933.25)
4. At 60 days before departure, the charge increases to 100% of full price.

5.1 EMERGENCY CANCELLATION: If the Client's entire group cannot travel because of a mutual decision made by the Client and the Agent due to unsafe travel conditions, the cancellation charge will be reduced to 12% of the total fare selected by the individual participant (Single, Double, or Triple occupancy) plus the cost of items such as event tickets, airline deposits, vendor penalties, hotel deposits, or any other payments made on the Client's behalf that become non-refundable prior to the cancellation date. The cost of these items will be added to the 12% cancellation charge assessed.

6. SIGN-UP WAIVER FORMS; ROOM, PASSENGER, AND EQUIPMENT LISTS SUBMITTED:

On or before the 90th day before departure, December 10, 2025, the Client agrees to present to the Agent with a completed room list, a complete equipment list that itemizes all pieces other than personal luggage (at additional cost) by dimension and weight, and a final airline passenger list, with proper formal names as they appear on each passenger's passport, (including nationality of each participant and an emergency contact with address and phone number). Airlines may require the submission of name, address and phone number for emergency notification. Passengers are limited to one suitcase (the sum of height, width, and depth not to exceed 50 inches and 50 lbs.), and an instrument or carryon (the sum of height, width, and depth not to exceed 35 inches or 20 lbs.) or in accordance with current airline baggage standards. *Groups having equipment other than luggage may be liable for oversize or excess luggage charges, depending on the policy of the airline.*

7. RESPONSIBILITY:

The Client agrees to have each passenger or guardian sign and submit a waiver of responsibility and information sheet (signup form), and if a minor, a Medical Proxy Form signed by his/her parent or legal guardian, to be in the possession of an administrator or staff member on the tour, which forms shall be maintained by the Client for five years in a form accessible to the Agent. The Client is responsible for informing all participants of the terms and conditions of this contract, including payment and cancellation charge schedules. The Agent reserves the right to decline, accept, or retain any participant as a member of this tour and shall not have responsibility to declined or terminated individuals beyond the refund of an appropriate portion of payment made by the participant to The Agent. The Agent reserves the right to send home any passenger with a chaperone at his/her own expense (including the cost of the chaperone), that is disruptive of the trip or engages in any illegal activity. The Agent acts only as agent in providing means of transportation, hotel, or other services. The Agent contracts only with reputable vendors and service-providers, and as such they bear the appropriate level of responsibility for their own services, which contracts are enforced by the Agent. All services, tickets, and vouchers are issued, offered or provided subject to any and all terms and conditions under which such services, tickets, and vouchers are offered and provided by the vendors, and the issuance and acceptance of such tickets and other services shall be deemed to be consent to the further condition that The Agent shall not be, nor become liable or responsible in any way for any loss, injury, or damage to or in respect of any person or property howsoever caused or arising in

connection with such means of transportation or other services offered by the Agent in the fulfillment of this contract, including the failure of any airline or losses that result therefrom. Should any interruption in services occur due to an act of God or circumstances beyond the control of the Agent, such as a missed flight due to inclement weather, the Agent will help the Client find the best solution to the difficulty, but any additional cost due to such a difficulty shall be the responsibility of the Client and/or it's individual participants. At all times during the tour the passengers' behavior and safety are the direct responsibility of the organization, school, or group sponsoring the tour, and it is the responsibility of each participant to behave in a responsible and safe manner. The Agent shall not be responsible for loss or damage to participant's baggage.

The prices quoted are based on tariffs, taxes, and/or foreign exchange rates as of May 6, 2026. In the event of a contractual change of tariff, currency exchange rate, or vendor, the right is reserved to make appropriate adjustment in prices. Furthermore, The Agent reserves the right to withdraw any portion or all of any travel package to make such alterations or substitutions in the travel package offered as it deems necessary or desirable to maintain the safety, value and integrity of the travel program. Should an element of the program become unavailable through accident, act of God, or other circumstance beyond The Agent's control, the Client will be consulted and The Agent will make substitutions that are superior or as close to equivalent as possible. Any payment made by or on behalf of Billy Ryan High School Choir constitutes full agreement to all of the terms contained in this agreement.
