Executive Summary: Annual Review of Major Contracts and Leases

Overview

As we approach the midpoint of the academic year and prepare for the upcoming calendar year, the portfolio of major contracts and leases are presented for Board review. This December review cycle is a critical component of our fiscal governance framework, ensuring that all external partnerships maximize value for our students and stakeholders while maintaining strict adherence to budgetary constraints.

Purpose of the Review
