At your direction, STR Building Resources LLC (STR-SEG) prepared a full set of masonry repair documents and placed them out for bids on March 31, 2020. A non-mandatory pre-bid conference call was held on April 6, 2020. Six bids were submitted and received by the Geneva Community Unit School District 304 on April 17, 2020.
