POLICY TITLE: Grading

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For grades (K) through (2), students achievement marks of satisfactory and unsatisfactory are used to designate classroom performance.

For grades three(3) through eight (8), students' progress and achievement shall be reported on the basis of the letter grades A, B, C, D, and F.

The letter grades interpreted will have the following numerical values:

 $\begin{array}{rcrr} A & = & 90\text{-}100 \\ B & = & 80\text{-}89 \\ C & = & 70\text{-}79 \\ D & = & 60\text{-}69 \\ F & = & \text{Below }60 \end{array}$

For grades nine (9) through twelve (12) students' progress and achievement shall be reported on the basis of the letter grades A+, A, A-, B+, B, B-, C+, C, C-, D+, D, D-. The grading is based on both-the regular grading scale and AP grading scale shownas below:
