No Bully Program

- The No Bully System[®] is a step-by-step process and set of interventions to prevent and stop bullying in school and after-school programs. It guides school leaders, teachers and staff through a series of interventions for responding to bullying and harassment, depending on the severity of the incident. When severe or persistent bullying occurs, teachers facilitate Solution Teams[®], where the target's peer group and the bully come together to stop the bullying.

No Bully Program

- Used in Over 200 Schools
- Based in San Francisco
- Over 100,000 Students
- 1 to 2 Years of Training and then School is Self-Sufficient
- Trains all Staff
- Training for Parents about Bullying and How to Bully Proof Kids
- Will be Paid for Using Grant Funds

No Bully Program

- Parent Survey
 - Over 73% of Parent Respondents Cited Bullying as an Issue at FCS
- FCS Staff
 - Recognize the Problem
 - Researched Several Programs to Find a Program that Fits FCS and the Other Initiatives in the School
 - Reached Consensus
 - Need to Educate Staff and Parents
