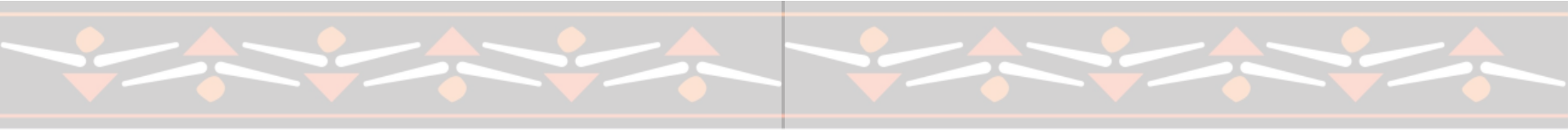

STUDENT-ATHLETES

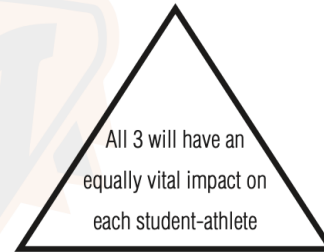
- *Character, academics and athletics will all be central components of MHS extracurriculars*

- 6th Place State Finish



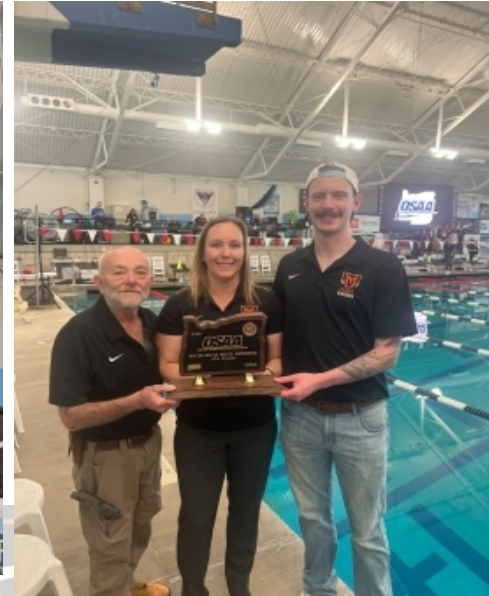
Unified Basketball

- 1st Place in State Tournament!!



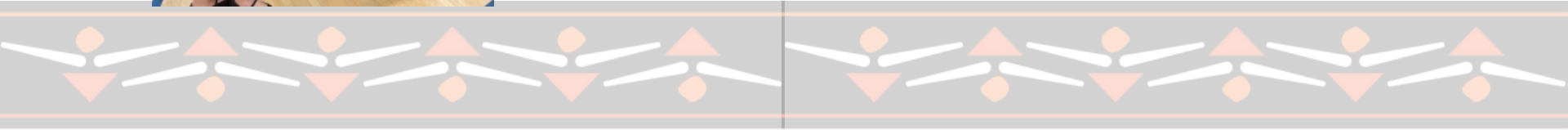
Boys and Girls Swimming

- 5th Place OSAA State Finish



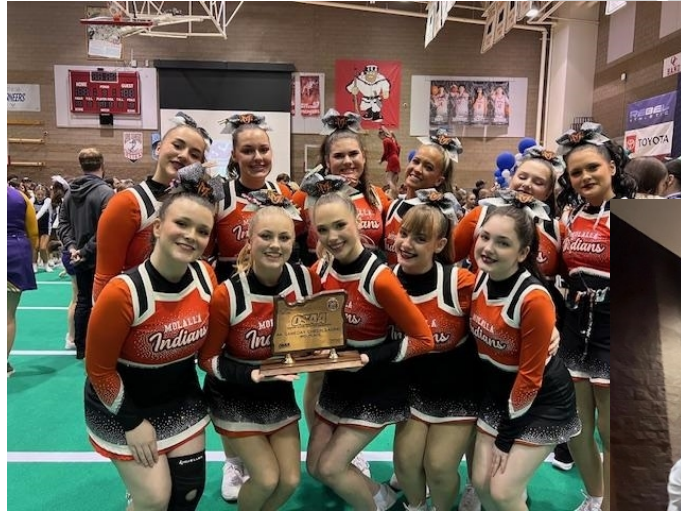
Boys and Girls Wrestling
