Purpose of Report

This report is to present to the Board of Trustees, for their review and discussion, an update of the TRS medical plan changes for 2020-2021, as well as new medical plans provided by Texas Schools Health Benefits Program (TSHBP) for their consideration.

Objectives

Review of plan benefits on an annual basis to keep the Board apprised of rate and benefit changes that are being made for the upcoming year along with new opportunities within the medical benefits marketplace.

Operational Impact

Current TRS Medical Plan Options & Changes:

At its February 21, 2020 meeting, the TRS Board selected Blue Cross Blue Shield of Texas (BCBSTX's) to serve as the new health plan administrator for TRS medical benefits. The contract will take effect Sept. 1, 2020. Blue Cross Blue Shield of Texas previously administered the program at its start in 2004 through 2014 when Aetna won the contract.

The TRS Board approved the benefit and rate changes during their April 16-17, 2020 Board Meeting.
